

Timeline for Jávea Area

Palaeolithic (Old Stone Age) - nomadic hunter-gatherers using primitive stone tools	c.750,000- c.10,000BC
Epipalaeolithic (or late-Palaeolithic, corresponding with Mesolithic in northern Europe) - hunter-gatherers, with more advanced tools	c.10,000- c5,000BC
Neolithic (New Stone Age) - beginning of agriculture (both crop-growing and animal husbandry)	c.5,000- c.2,000BC
Chalcolithic (Copper Age)	c2,000-c1,800BC
Bronze Age , using the copper-tin alloy	c1,800-c800BC
Iron Age and Iberian culture	c800-200BC
Roman	c.200BC-cAD500
Early Middle Ages - Visigothic	cAD500-c715
Early-High Middle Ages - Moorish , part of al-Andalus	cAD715-1244
Late Middle Ages - in Kingdom of Aragón, following Christian Reconquest	AD1244-1516
Modern , after Spain fully unified on accession of Carlos I	AD1516-present
